What the judges are looking for:

This category recognises any company at the forefront of training innovation. Excellence may be demonstrated through a new initiative, campaign, tool, system or process. Innovations should benefit individual workers, equipping them for a career in demolition while making them more productive, more responsible and – ultimately – safer.

What to include

- A description of the training innovation
- How will the innovation benefit specific projects including specific career progression and/or health and safety advantages
- How the innovation could be utilised on a wider scale to benefit the wider industry
- Full response to each key point. You are encouraged to include client testimonials
- Up to six hi-res photographs
- Your company logo
- You can also include a video (where appropriate) of up to 100MB in size
