When submitting your entries please try to give as much relevant and concise information as possible. This will enable the judges to fully understand your nomination, and to assess it fairly against other entrants.

Who can enter?

Any demolition contractor operating in the UK.

What the judges are looking for:

This category recognises any company that can demonstrate its understanding of risk on a specific contract or a specific element of a larger contract, how this was factored into the creation of a detailed risk assessment/method statement, and how that risk assessment/method statement was managed and amended as the contract progressed.

What to include

- Details of the overall contract or a specific portion thereof
- A copy of the risk assessment/method statement
- Additional/supporting information that you provided to aid client understanding/engagement
- Full response to each key point. You are encouraged to include client testimonials
- Up to six hi-res photographs
- Your company logo
- You can also include a video (where appropriate) of up to 100MB in size
