Who can enter?

Any individual who has successfully completed an apprenticeship or training course with a contractor, sub-contractor, supplier or consultant operating in the UK demolition industry.

What the judges are looking for:

This category recognises the high standard of achievement by an apprentice or trainee and who is an excellent ambassador for the sector and its future. The judges will be looking for evidence of:

- Dedication to the course or apprenticeship
- Skills developed and the journey the individual has been on
- Ability to use own initiative in relation to the learning/training process
- Why this person is an outstanding advocate for the sector and encouraging future talent

What to include

- Details of the nominated person
- Details of the training provided and the qualifications gained
- You are encouraged to include testimonials from clients, co-workers and/or training providers
- Up to six hi-res photographs
- Your company logo
- You can also include a video (where appropriate) of up to 100MB in size
